Personal Representatives (Executors and Administrators) When you die, you leave an estate that consists of your property, as well as unpaid bills and debts. Your property must be distributed to your heirs or to your beneficiaries and your unpaid bills and debts must be paid.

## **Personal Representatives (Executors and Administrators)**

A Personal Representative (commonly referred to as an Executor) of an estate is an individual or institution designated to administer the estate of a decedent. As a fiduciary, a Personal Representative must settle and distribute the estate of the decedent as efficiently as possible by adhering to the directions outlined in the decedent's Last Will and Testament and/or the probate laws of the state where the estate is being administered.

Courts don't like Co-Executors and Co-Trustees: While I have witnessed Colorado Courts appoint multiple personal representatives to act on an estate's behalf, the Colorado law doesn't really give guidance on how to administer a probate proceeding when two personal representatives are appointed.

## **THE PROBLEMS WITH USING CO-TRUSTEES OR CO-PERSONAL RE**

The executor's two primary rights are the right to decline the role and the right to compensation for work performed. If a person dies with a will, the executor is usually named in the will. If no executor is named, the court appoints an executor based on state law. In either case, the proposed executor can decline to take on the role.
