Preparing for the Neonatal Resuscitation Program NRP Skills

The TORA group had higher behavior skill scores in 8 of the 10 NRP key behavioral skills and had higher overall behavioral skill scores (control = 30.1 [\pm 7.2] vs. TORA = 34.9 [\pm 4.8]; $p < 0.001$). CONCLUSION: In resuscitation teams comprising mostly resident physicians, TORA training resulted in better behavioral skills during simulated neonatal resuscitation.
